

safety in your community



out and about in your community

Your community will continue to grow into a strong and vibrant community for many years to come. However, along the way, we must all remain aware and alert about safety aspects that come with developing a new community like ours.

keep out of construction sites

Where you see a construction site, do not under any circumstances enter the site. Drivers of large machinery constructing new subdivisions and houses are less likely to see cars or people walking or cycling around construction sites - especially children.

There are many other hazards including uneven surfaces, mud, building materials and other debris. Please advise children of these hazards and to stay clear of these areas.



parking your car

Consider your neighbours when parking on the street - is there room in your driveway for your car? Is there room for other road users to pass your parked vehicle?

Don't park on the nature strips or across driveways/footpaths as it can impede pedestrians.

out driving

Be cautious and aware of large trucks delivering material to areas where there are homes or subdivisions under construction.

Please drive slowly and keep your eye out for young children crossing or playing in the street. And remember, most of our local streets are 50km.



keep out of undeveloped areas

The undeveloped areas of your community are private property and therefore not accessible to the general public.

These areas may be undergoing preliminary survey and engineering works. Please advise children to stay clear of these areas.





out walking

Look out for paths under construction or repair. If you're out walking in the evening, take a torch with you or stay within well-lit areas.



out cycling

Wear your helmet at all times, and please be aware of sections of hike and bike paths under construction or repair.

Also, pedestrians share the paths, so please cycle slowly and indicate when passing.

Ride carefully. Keep an eye out for construction and private vehicles.
